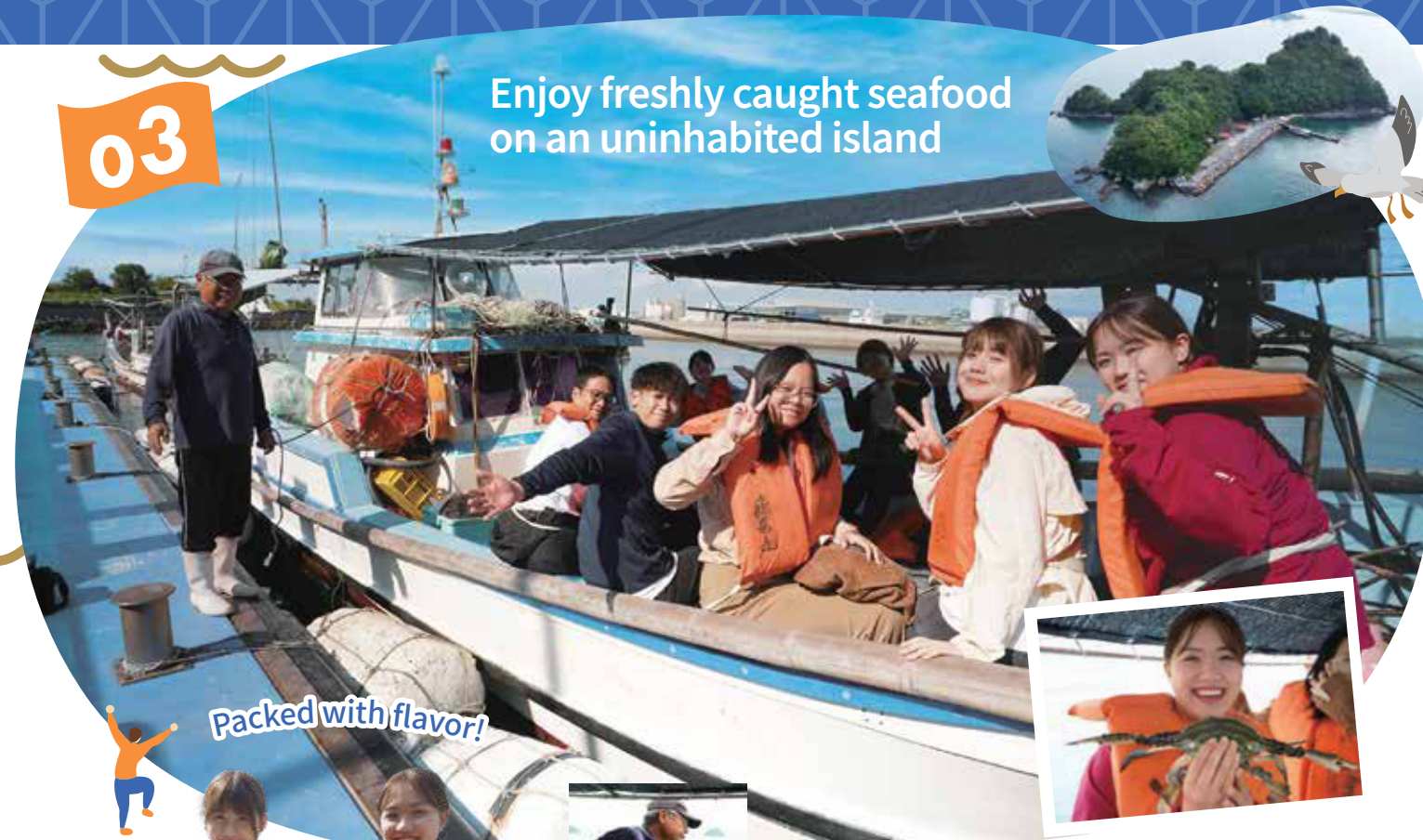

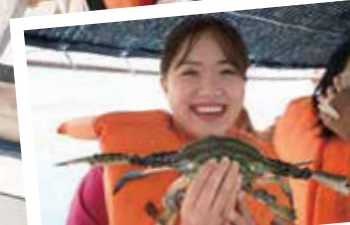

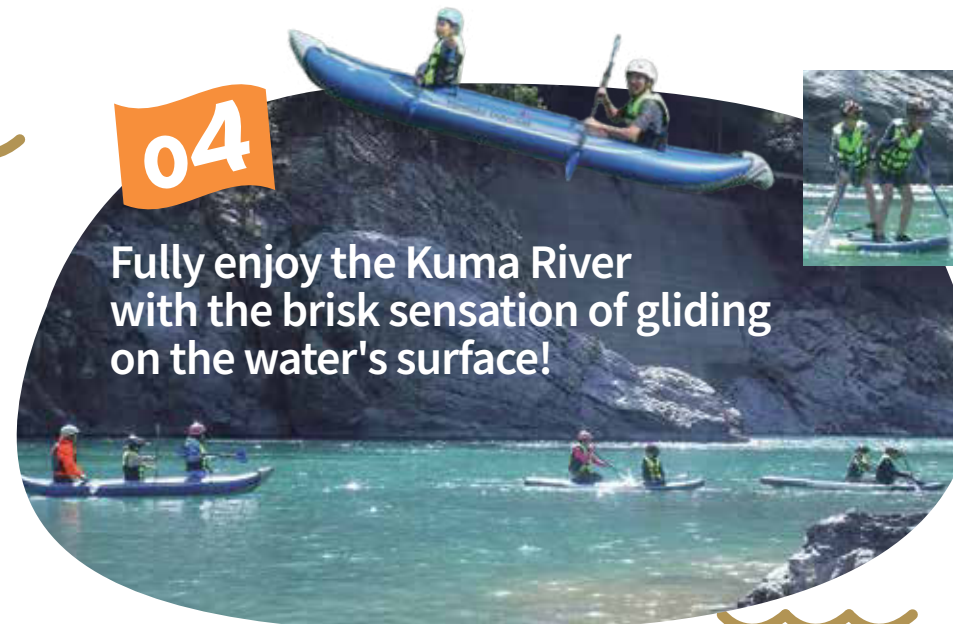

The masons of Yatsushiro

~The stone-making legacy of Masonry Town~

In Kumamoto, there are still many old-fashioned "arched bridges." Many of them were created by stonemasons born and raised in Yatsushiro. Their skills were highly regarded throughout Japan, and they were involved in the construction of the Kanda Sujikai Megane Bridge (Manseibashi, Tokyo) and the national treasure Tsujunkyo Bridge (Yamato Town). Their skills became well-known throughout the country, and Yatsushiro became famous as the "hometown of stonemasons." The bridges built by these stonemasons and the stories woven around the 25 cultural properties related to them have been designated as JAPAN HERITAGE.

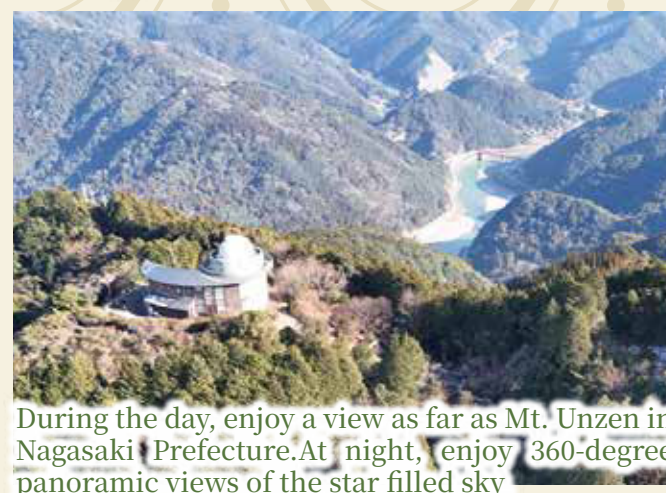

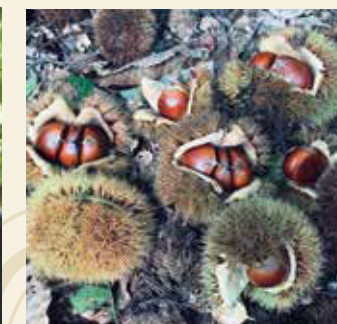

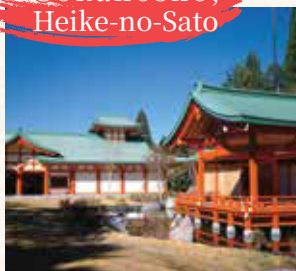
Introducing the romantic legend of the survivors

The mansion offers glimpses of the legend of the fallen clan, such as hidden rooms. The Zouza-Ke Mansion is said to have been the place where the eldest son of Sugawara no Michizane hid to avoid being pursued by the Fujiwara clan.

The Momigi Suspension Bridge is an unusual "parent-child suspension bridge" consisting of two parallel bridges. The upper bridge is the Ayatori Bridge (72m long and 35m high) and the lower bridge is the Shakunage Bridge (59m long and 17m high). From the observation deck, you can enjoy a panoramic view of the two bridges in all their beauty.

Boasting a length of 116 m, this is the longest suspension bridge in Gokanoshō. Without ropes or supporting pillars, it gives you the sensation of floating in the air. 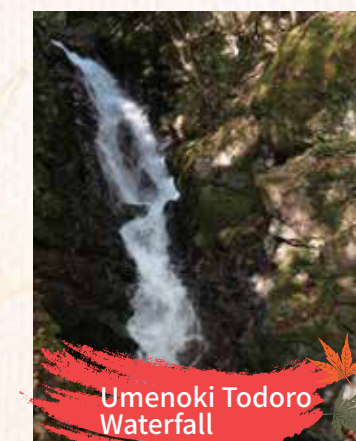

Home to History and Stonemasons

Toyo-Machi is the hometown of masons. The Taneyama Masons, who worked in the former Taneyama area, built many of the arched bridges that are still an integral part of daily life today.

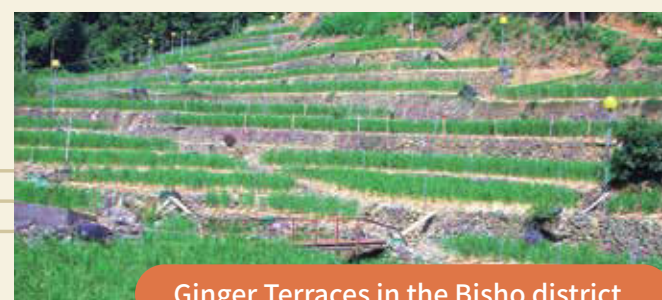

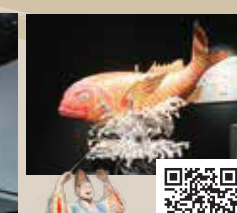

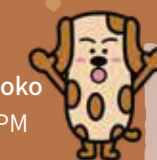

Known as both Yatsushiro and Koda ware, the pottery began in the early Edo period when Kizo Agano, a member of the Hosokawa family who was transferred to Higo, started it in the Koda township of Yatsushiro, near Hinagu. Yatsushiro(Koda) ware is characterized by the technique of inlaying, where a pattern is carved into a half-dried base, and feldspar is embedded into the recesses of the carving. The challenging 'celadon inlay' technique, which involves multiple steps, has been passed down through generations. Currently, the 12th generation, Hiroyuki Agano and his eldest son Kohei, are in charge of the kiln. The studio displays works with elegant colors and refined shapes that captivate viewers. Credit cards are accepted.

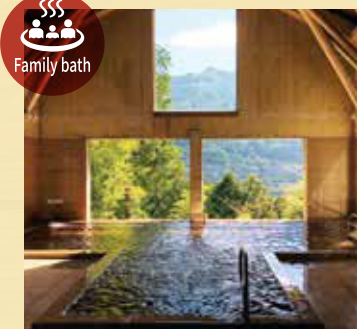

The area around Iwaduto mountain in Izumi-Machi Gokasou is a spot overflowing with Fukujusou (Japanese Adonis)
- ② **Garyubai - Sleeping dragon plum** (around February)
The plum trees in the grounds of Matsui Shrine are over 350 years old.
- ③ **Shakunage - Rhododendrons** (around April)
The Gokanosho area in Izumi-Machi is also known for its beautifully blooming rhododendrons.
- ④ **Sakura - Cherry Blossoms** (late March)
Yatsushiro has many famous places for viewing cherry blossoms, and among them, the Site of Yatsushiro Castle views are truly breathtaking.
- ⑤ **Botan - peonies** (around April to May)
The stunning peony blossoms bloom every year at Akahoshi Park in Kagami-Machi.
- ⑥ **Yatsushirosou - Clustered Bellflowers** (around May to June)
Their Japanese name stems from being originally found in Yatsushiro during the Edo period (1603-1868).
- ⑦ **Tea Fields** (around April to May)
Izumi-Machi is famous for its tea production, and the utilized mountain slopes are covered in a beautiful green.
- ⑧ **Higo Hanashoubu - Higo Irises** (late May to early June)
Every year, about 5,000 flowers bloom at the Shohinken.
- ⑨ **Ajisai - Hydrangeas** (around June)
Colorful flowers bloom along the Kuma River bank and in Furumoto.
