A castle built by Masakata Kato. It received special protection to keep it safe when the shogunate issued the one castle per province law. With its stone walls made of limestone, it is also called the "White Heron" Castle.

A museum with a novel design. With exhibits like the Matsui Library Collection, it's an introduction to the history and culture of Yatsushiro.

Both restaurant and specialty products corner are here. All creative cuisine, fresh-picked vegetables, processed foods and souvenirs can be purchased.




### 7 Matsunaka Nobuhiko Sports Museum


